Speech without an adverbial

“You look great,” she said.

Speech with an **adverbial**

“You look great,” she said, **while admiring her dress.**

Remember an adverbial gives you more information about what the person is doing while they are speaking.

Here are some examples of adverbials you might choose to use in your conversation with Jazz.

while looking out the window, as she pointed towards Earth,
while brushing her hair behind her ears, nodding her head.

Remember to put a comma before you write your adverbial.
