| <b>Initiative:</b>          | <i>An introductory act or step; leading action</i>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To take the initiative in making friends</li> <li>To take the initiative in solving a problem</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Creative Thinking:</b>   | <i>The ability to think creatively to solve problems or situations</i>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Being able to look at a problem in school from a fresh perspective and suggest alternative solutions.</li> <li>Is litter in the playground an issue? Could you think creatively to find a way of solving this?</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Determination:</b>       | <i>To persevere, work hard and reach your goal no matter what.</i>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To be determined to finish a school race and run the whole way</li> <li>Is your school fair-trade? Could you be determined to convince the teachers and governors to become a Fair-trade school, not giving up until you've achieved the goal?</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Courage:</b>             | <i>To be brave, bold and show strength and endurance.</i>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To speak up about a problem in school or in the community – for example bullying.</li> <li>To do something you're not so confident in - could you speak in assembly about an issue in the world or about a local charity?</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Decisive:</b>            | <i>To have the ability to see what needs doing and make clear decisions to make it happen.</i>                      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Are you good at making good decisions? Can you see a problem and fix it?</li> <li>What about sitting on the school council and making positive decisions which will change your school for the better?</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Communication:</b>       | <i>To be able to clearly pass on your thoughts and opinions in various ways – through speech, writing, signs...</i> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do you like speaking or writing?</li> <li>How about organising an evening to share about the Young Leaders Award with other schools or parents and governors?</li> <li>Could you write an article for your local paper about this award or about an issue that needs changing in the community?</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Conflict Resolution:</b> | <i>To be able to solve a problem or dispute and bring peace</i>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do you notice arguments in school about particular things (equipment, space, friendship groups)? How could these be resolved?</li> <li>How about mentoring some younger pupils who are struggling in school or find themselves in conflicts...</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Managing Others:</b>     | <i>To take charge or care of a group of people helping them to achieve their goals.</i>                             | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Could you help run an activity club in school and manage the group effectively?</li> <li>Do you like sports? How about helping the teachers to manage some of the younger sports teams in school?</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Organisation</b>         | <i>To be able to plan well and see all the tasks that needs completing. To structure those tasks effectively.</i>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do you like organising people and tasks? Could you take a lead role in planning an event for a charity or for your school?</li> <li>Could you help guide classes into the assembly making sure they are sat in the right places?</li> <li>Are there areas in school which are a little untidy? Could you get them organised for everyone to be able to use?</li> </ul> |
| <b>Teamwork</b>             | <i>Being able to work well with others to achieve the goal</i>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How about forming a small team and choosing a charity to fundraise for over the next year? Could you all take on different roles – one person to speak about the charity, one person to make posters, one person to collect money etc...?</li> </ul>   |
