

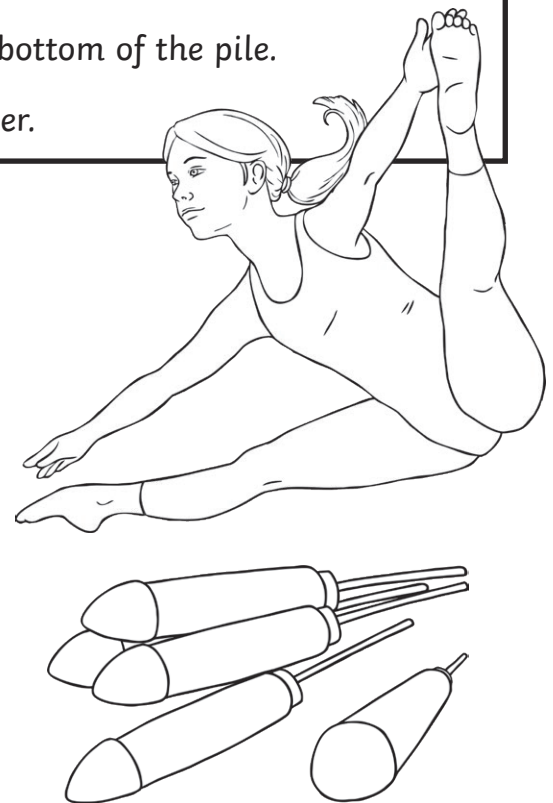
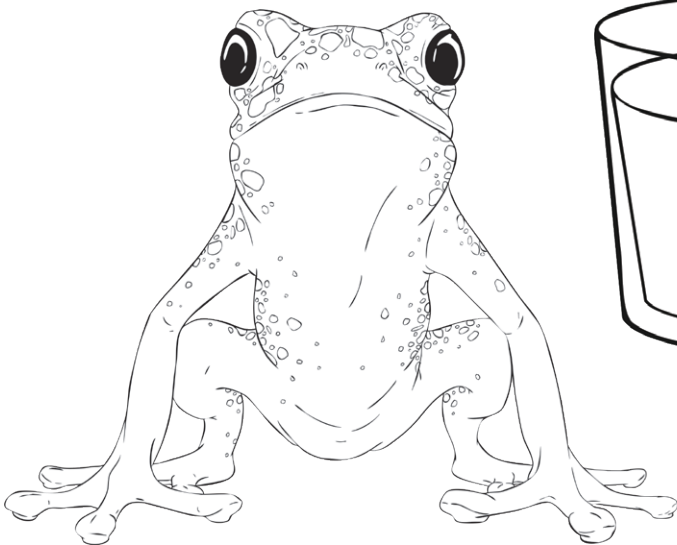
Play It Safe Game

Instructions:

You will need the Play It Safe Game board, the three sets of cards (Risk Cards, Danger Cards and Safe Cards), different coloured counters and a dice.

How to play:

- Set out the board where everyone can see it and sort the cards into three piles – Risk Cards, Danger Cards and Safe Cards.
- Place a different coloured counter for each player on the start space.
- Roll the dice to see who goes first – the highest number goes first, then play moves to the left.
- On your turn, roll the dice and move that number of spaces.
- Read and follow the instruction on the space you land on.
- If you land on a space that tells you to move forwards or backwards, carry out that instruction and then play passes to the next player.
- If you land on a space telling you to pick up a card, do so, read the card and follow the instructions. Once you have moved forwards or backwards, play passes to the next player.
- When a player has used a card, they place it to the bottom of the pile.
- The first player to reach the finish space is the winner.
