

Make a paper lantern

Tip: If you want to save time on colouring, you could print out page 2 on red or yellow paper or card.

You will need:

- Page 2 of the worksheet
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Things to decorate your lantern with, i.e. pens, glitter, ribbon, stickers, sequins, etc.

Instructions:

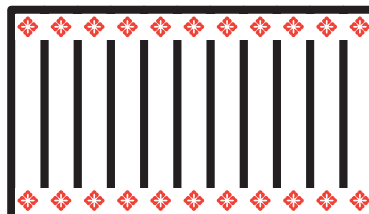
Print out page 2 of this worksheet. Fold the paper along the dotted lines and then cut along the straight lines.



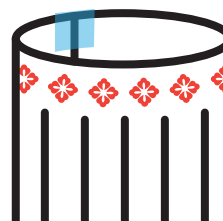
Unfold the paper. It will have a row of vertical slits along the middle!



Decorate your lantern, particularly the top and bottom solid strips.



Mould the paper into a tube shape to make it into a lantern! Use the sticky tape to hold the sides in place.



Now stick the handle to each side. You could now attach ribbons or fabric to make streamers from the bottom of your lantern.
