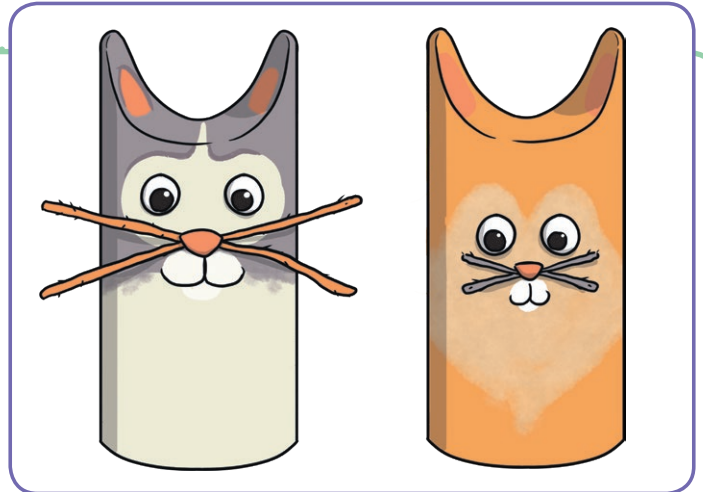


# Cardboard Cat Craft

## You will need:

- Cardboard tube (one per child)
- Black, white, brown and orange paint (depending on what colour your cat will be)
- Paintbrushes
- Goggly eyes (one pair per child)
- Glue
- Pipe cleaners (two per child)
- Pom-poms



- Scissors
- Black marker pen

## Instructions

1. Choose what colour you want your cat to be. You could choose grey and white, like Harold, or use orange paint to make a ginger cat, like Muffin! Cats come in lots of different colours.
2. Paint your cardboard tube all over. Leave it to dry.
3. Once your tube is completely dry, it's time to make the cat's ears! Gently, push down the top of your cardboard tube on opposite sides. They should be folded inwards.
4. Glue the googly eyes onto your cardboard cat.
5. Carefully, cut one of your pipe cleaners in half. Fold each half in the middle so they both make a 'V' shape.
6. Glue the two V-shaped pipe cleaners under the cat's eyes to make your whiskers. Hold them in place to allow the glue to dry.
7. Glue a pom-pom nose over the top of the whiskers.
8. Curl the end of the other pipe cleaner. Glue this to the back of the cardboard cat as its tail.
9. Use the marker pen to draw the cat's mouth.
10. Finally, give your cat a name!
