
Cardboard Cat Craft

You will need:

- Cardboard tube (one per child)
- Black, white, brown and orange paint (depending on what colour your cat will be)
- Paintbrushes
- Googly eyes (one pair per child)
- Glue
- Pipe cleaners (two per child)
- Pom-poms

Instructions

- Choose what colour you want your cat to be. You could choose grey and white, like Harold, or use orange paint to make a ginger cat, like Muffin! Cats come in lots of different colours.
- Paint your cardboard tube all over. Leave it to dry.
- 3. Once your tube is completely dry, it's time to make the cat's ears! Gently, push down the top of your cardboard tube on opposite sides. They should be folded inwards.
- Glue the googly eyes onto your cardboard cat.



- Carefully, cut one of your pipe cleaners in half. Fold each half in the middle so they both make a 'V' shape.
- 6. Glue the two V-shaped pipe cleaners under the cat's eyes to make your whiskers. Hold them in place to allow the glue to dry.
- **7.** Glue a pom-pom nose over the top of the whiskers.
- 8. Curl the end of the other pipe cleaner. Glue this to the back of the cardboard cat as its tail.
- 9. Use the marker pen to draw the cat's mouth.
- 10. Finally, give your cat a name!
