The recent news updates on the Corona Virus show that the outbreak in this country is increasing and, if the empty shelves in the shops are anything to go by, a certain level of panic is setting in. I am receiving regular updates from Public Health England and Cheshire East Council with specific guidance for schools. The advice is still at this stage to promote hand washing as the best form of spreading the virus. I know some parents have asked me about hand washing breaks and supervision to ensure pupils wash their hands properly. I can assure you that all practical steps are being taken by staff to promote clean hands in school. It is in all our interests to promote hand hygiene in this way. Each evening, our caretaking staff have re-doubled their efforts to ensure that classrooms and regularly used surfaces are germ free.
