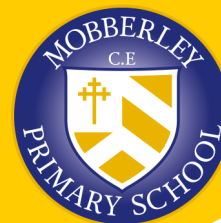

WEEK EVENTS

Dear Parent / Carer,

There is only one issue which should dominate all of our minds this week – the Corona Virus outbreak. As each day passes, the magnitude of the issue appears to increase as does the severity of response needed to limit the spread of the outbreak. Some commentators are calling it the defining challenge of our time, requiring a collective 'war time' effort to defeat it. Thankfully, most people (including the young) suffer relatively mild symptoms and recover well. However, the really significant risk to our community lies in passing on the virus to the older generation and those with underlying health conditions.

Government advice indicates that the peak of the outbreak could be 10-12 weeks away and will have a profound impact on our way of life. We have already moved into the second stage of the Government's action plan. What does this mean for us in Mobblerley School:

- Any pupil (or staff member) showing the symptoms of a high temperature and/or a dry cough should stay at home for a minimum of 7 days or until any symptoms/all have disappeared. Please report the absence to the school office, preferably by email.
- Any pupil (or adult) observed in school with a high temperature and/or a dry cough will be sent home as a precaution.

I do ask for parents understanding with these measures. I know the inconvenience caused to working parents, however, we must do everything we can to protect our community and those most at risk.

I also think we need to plan ahead for possible school closures. This step has been taken by many countries throughout Europe and is part of the Government plan. I will update parents regularly as appropriate.

Thank you for your support and understanding at this time.
