Glitter Unicorn Footprint Art

You will need:

Plain paper

Pink paint

Paintbrush

Black marker pen

Googly eyes

Glitter

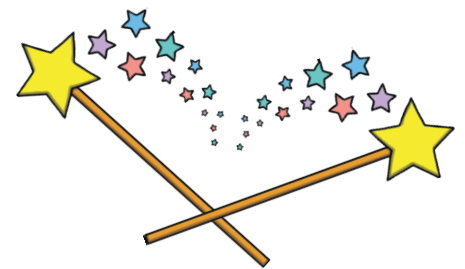
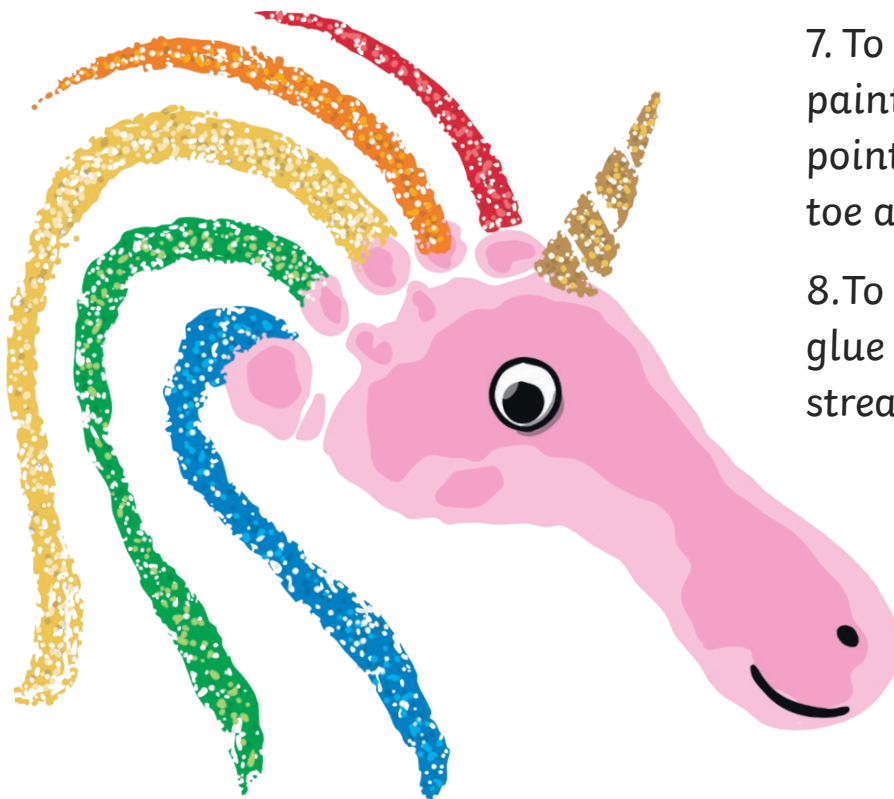
Glue

Instructions:

1. Use your left foot for this activity. Paint pink paint over the sole of your foot.
2. Orientate the paper so that the footprint will be diagonally across the paper with the heel pointing towards the bottom left hand corner of the paper and the little toe pointing upwards.
3. Quickly and firmly press your foot on to the plain paper.
4. Wait for the paint to dry.
5. Your heel will form the unicorn's nose and mouth. Use the marker pen to draw a dot for the nostril and a small curve for the smile.
6. Glue one googly eye on to the ball of the foot.

7. To form the unicorn's horn, paint or glue a cone shape pointing upwards from the little toe and sprinkle with glitter.

8. To make the unicorn's mane, glue outwards from the toes in streaks and sprinkle with glitter.

Sparkly Rainbow Playdough

This fun and sparkly unicorn rainbow playdough is great fun to make and even more fun to play with!

You will need:

1 cup flour

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup salt

2 tsp cream of tartar

1 cup boiling water

1 tbsp vegetable oil

Food colouring (bright unicorn colours of your choice – blue, pink, yellow, etc.)

Glitter

Scented essential oil (optional to add sweet scents to your unicorn playdough)

Note: To create different colours for a rainbow effect, you will need to repeat this process with a different food colouring each time.



Tip: You may wish to use plastic gloves and an apron to prevent hands and clothes from being stained by the food colouring.

Instructions:

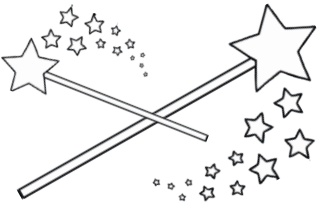
1. Mix the flour, salt and cream of tartar in a saucepan.
2. In a separate bowl, mix the water and the food colouring (and the essential oil if using it).
3. Pour the liquid mixture into the saucepan and mix together thoroughly.
4. When all the ingredients are combined together and cool enough to touch, roll out on to a flat surface and sprinkle with glitter (the more glitter you add, the sparklier it will be). Knead the mixture together.
5. The playdough is ready to use.

To create a rainbow effect, twist different coloured playdoughs together.
