

The 'new normal' in school is very much established now and in many ways it is strange to think of how things were before one way systems and squirty gel. Having said that, there is nothing quite like a whole school assembly or hymn practice to get that sense of school community and togetherness that we miss very much at the minute.

In the last week we have seen positive cases and classes sent home from Knutsford High and St Vincent's, Knutsford - two nearby schools within our local cluster. Within Cheshire East there are 814 pupils and 35 staff across 14 schools either positive cases/self-isolating as a precaution. The rate within the county has risen significantly within the last week although we are lower than other neighboring areas.

With the background of these trends, we will continue to take all necessary precautions but it may be prudent for parents to consider childcare arrangements should we need to isolate a class bubble (typically 14 days) at short notice. I have had to do this same task for my daughter this weekend and it comes as quite a shock. As with all of the risk assessments we do in school - we plan for the worst case scenario but hope that the reality of the situation is much better. A package of virtual teaching will be in place to support isolating bubbles in this
