WEEK EVENTS

Dear Parent / Carer,

I hope you and your families enjoyed the Autumnal weather of the weekend and made best use of it. Thank you for all of your Harvest donations – our Y6 Young Leaders will be helping to organize and distribute these during the week.

We live in interesting times and our ability to do some of the things we enjoy will likely face further restrictions later today when the Prime Minister makes a formal announcement about steps to prevent further spread of the virus.

I have to inform you that the Covid picture locally has become significantly more serious. Public Health England tells us that an increase of 198 cases were recorded in Cheshire East in the last 14 days and the county has now been placed on a national 'watch list.' Admissions have increased at both Macclesfield and Leighton hospitals. Within schools, there are currently 1108 children and 118 staff self-isolating which is impacting 28 settings. While all age groups have shown increases, the 18-29 group are experiencing the largest spike at present.

It is important to take a broad view with these things and there are some positives for us. The data doesn't imply that the re-opening of schools has caused a significant spike, Primaries are faring better than Secondary Schools and EYFS rates are very low. Importantly, transmission rates after an identified positive case are low which might suggest 'bubble self-isolation' measures are working.

It would be prudent for us all to stay 'on alert.' Please ensure social distancing around the school site, particularly in the queue at drop-off and pick-up. The wearing of masks by adults at these times has been suggested by some schools locally as a precaution. At this stage, I do not want to impose a blanket policy but we must ensure appropriate distance to keep everybody safe.

Thank you for your ongoing, fantastic co-operation. Together, we will try to find a way through this to the brighter times that lie ahead for us and our children.
