WEEK EVENTS

Dear Parent / Carer,

As we approach the half term break, I hope the children enjoy a well-earned rest. I know the staff here are ready for a short break after what has been a rewarding, yet challenging first 8 weeks. I have to compliment the children for adapting so well to the new hygiene routines and sticking to them throughout the term. Obviously, this is due, in no small part, to the staff for their consistent approach and regular reminders to wash hands, etc. Well done to all.

Locally, the Covid picture is quite critical. Infection rates are running at around 153 cases per 100,000, placing Cheshire East within tier 2 restrictions. Feedback from the local Authority is that identified positive cases in school tend to come from the community. They say that school prevention strategies (bubble isolation, hygiene, etc.) are impacting positively to contain the spread following individual cases. There is some concern from the council that cases may rise as children return to school in November after circulating within the community. Although we are all desperate for some social interaction, I would ask all parents to be extremely mindful of protective measures over the break. We have been relatively lucky so far but we don't want to see children becoming unwell. Also, speaking as a parent whose child has just completed a precautionary 14 days of isolation, it is extremely limiting and inconvenient. We all have a responsibility to ensure our safety.

Hot options will be re-introduced at dinnertime today and will continue each day within children's picnic bags. Full cooked meals are unfortunately just not possible for us at this time but I hope this move will improve the variety and enjoyment of dinnertimes.

We continue our work to inform and educate children about healthy food. This Friday we welcome elite Nutritionist Matt Gardner (Nuffield Health) who will speak to all children (socially distanced) about eating well and good physical/mental health. Have a good week ahead.
