WEEK EVENTS

Dear Parent / Carer,

We have now had two full weeks back in school and hopefully you, like us in school, have adjusted back to this new kind of normality.

It has been good in so many ways to see the children mixing and chatting once again. I know one of the biggest aspects of the recent lockdown has been the social isolation. For many of our children and we are only now seeing the full impact of the pandemic on our children. Staff have observed some children with slightly different behaviour patterns over the past ten days, which might suggest slightly raised levels of anxiety or frustration, etc. Please ring or email your child's class teacher if you are concerned about how the recent lockdown has impacted your child. We will be here to help and support wherever possible.

Over the next fortnight, the children in all classes will undertake some small assessments to check on their understanding of key concepts. We will be able to discuss aspects of how the children have settled back into school and information gained from the assessments with you in the planned parent's evenings.

I would ask that if parents wish to discuss a certain matter in more detail, e.g. SEND issues, that another appointment is made with the class teacher in order to make sure every parent gets their time allocation without overrunning.

Teachers will be stressing the need for all children to ensure they read for a minimum of ten minutes every day. Reading is one of the best ways for children to improve their spoken and written language.
