Dear Parent / Carer,

Last Wednesday, we gathered in St Wilfrid's church as a school, together to sing and pray. We welcomed the new Reception children to our community, and we looked forward to a busy year ahead.

Parents of the new reception cohort will have their 'Meet the teacher' meetings tonight. It will give you a chance to gain more information about how the children learn in reception and the weekly routines, especially if your family are new to Mobblerley School. We have decided that all other classes will have virtual/recorded 'Meet the teacher' meetings this term to avoid large numbers of adults on the school site at this time.

Many staff have mentioned to me in the last week, how busy it feels within school. I think this is because we are all been so separated for so long and it is the coming together which is taking just a little bit of getting used to. Our current provision certainly feels like 'school as it used to be.'

You will notice that the school calendar is filling up with school trips, music lessons, competitive fixtures against other schools and extra-curricular clubs, etc. I have no doubt that the children and parents will also find things 'busy' until we all get used to the new pace of things. Therefore, I would ask you all to check the events in the week ahead carefully and make sure your children are clear on clubs being attended and collection arrangements, etc. so that confusion can be avoided.

I would also ask that all items needed for the school day are taken into school by the children (as far as possible) so that unnecessary drop-offs of kit, water bottles, instruments, inhalers, forms, monies, etc. are not needed.

Thank you for ensuring children arrive for school in good time to start their lessons. Remember the gates close at 8.55 so that children can hand up their coats, bags, etc. and be ready to **start learning at 9am promptly**. In this way, the children are given a very focused start to each morning.
