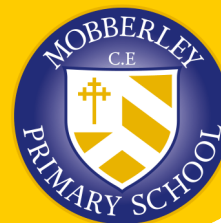

## WEEK EVENTS

Dear Parent / Carer,

You may be aware that we have had a few cases of confirmed Covid in the past week. Thankfully, our cases are far fewer than some other local schools, who seem to have been really quite badly impacted. We also have the normal coughs and colds that you would associate with this time of year. We are, obviously, on the lookout for children with any Covid symptoms, although recent cases have shown us that children present with a whole range of issues such as headache, temperature, sore eyes, runny nose, cough, sore tummy, fatigue, etc. All of these and then some children can be asymptomatic showing no difference whatsoever.

Parents may also be aware that the Covid rate in Primary Schools is now higher than the Secondaries. Regular LFT testing within families is still the best way to pick up cases – they have prevented significant spread within school this term. We obviously want the children in school at every opportunity; however, it is worth being cautious if your child is showing any signs of being unwell. If your child is poorly in any way, please arrange a PCR test which will give you the reassurance that the matter is non-Covid related. This gives everyone clarity and protects our community from sickness and further disruption to learning and planned events.

Thank you to everyone who attended the PTA Bingo night last Friday. It was a wonderful turnout and raised over £1k for the school. A huge thank you to Mrs Eadie for making the evening so enjoyable for everyone.

Also, thank you for the generous donations of bottles for the PTA Xmas Fair being held on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> Dec at 3.30pm. It will be wonderful to hold events such as this again after the enforced period of absence.
