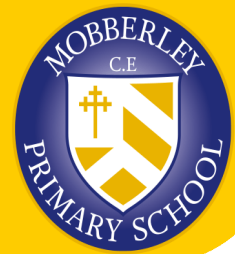

Dear Parent / Carer,

All of us at Mobblerley School watched together with the nation as Queen Elizabeth II was laid to rest on Monday. We are grateful to our Monarch for her dutiful service to the country and her inspiration to all of us. May she rest in peace, I know the children will have been deeply moved by recent events and for some children, the events will trigger painful feelings of losing other family members. As always, we will be providing strong emotional support for the children in their classes through circle times and discussions. We are also very fortunate at Mobblerley to be able to offer individual support through Mrs Knowles and Mrs Ashworth who are both highly trained to deliver ELSA (Emotional Literacy) interventions with children who need a higher level of support. In this way, we can ensure that every child is well supported to deal with anxieties and regain their confidence.

I am very pleased that the children have settled extremely well into their new classes and appear to be working well in their new school books. Behaviour throughout the school is calm and focused. A reminder that PE kit can be worn to school on days when sport is taking place. On all other days, uniform rules should be observed including **black school shoes**. **Earrings** should be avoided (unless small studs) and holiday **hair braids** and **coloured / fashion hair** styles are not appropriate for term time. Bangles, chains and other jewellery should also not come to school. In supporting us with these simple things, parents are helping to ensure there are less distractions in school, contributing to that focused atmosphere. I hope the 'Meet the Teacher' meetings were useful and you were able to see the children's classrooms. We very much hope that the friendly, informal teacher / parent relationship can be restored to pre-pandemic times and we can avoid the need for lengthy, impersonal emails.

I very much enjoyed our first 'Afternoon Tea' with Golden Certificate winners last week. This reward of juice and cakes / biscuits with me will happen each Friday to recognise those pupils who have worked exceptionally hard and behaved very well during the week.
